

Meat Purchase Agreement

This contract is between Pleasant Grove Farms, LLC hereafter referred to as Farm and _____ hereafter referred to as Buyer.

The Buyer understands and agrees to all of the provisions of the contract which are as follows:

Product.

The Buyer is agreeing to purchase beef as stipulated below:

- A live animal "on hoof" prior to harvest
- Whole Carcass based on hanging weight
- Half Carcass based on hanging weight
- Family Package: _____ (insert package name)

Purchase Price & Deposit.

With respect to one-half or whole cow purchases, the Purchase Price will be:

- a. \$ 7.50 per pound, hanging weight. Hanging weight is determined and provided by the processor after slaughter.
- c. A Deposit of \$750.00 is hereby acknowledged and shall be applied to the final purchase price, with the deposit being be non-refundable unless the Farm fails to deliver said animal in accordance with this agreement.

With respect to Family Package, the Purchase Price will be \$ _____.

- a. A Deposit equal to 1/3 of the Purchase Price is hereby acknowledged and shall be applied to the final purchase price, with the deposit being be non-refundable unless the Farm fails to deliver said animal in accordance with this agreement

Payment of Balance.

With respect to one-half or whole cow purchases, an Additional Deposit of \$750.00 shall be paid to Farm not less than five (5) days from notice being provided to Buyer by the Farm as to the scheduled date of processing and prior to Transportation and Delivery of Cattle to Processor.

Each deposit shall be credited towards the total Purchase Price upon Processor validating the Hanging Weight of the Cattle.

The final balance for the Purchase Price of the animal product will be determined as outlined above. Final payment is due within five days after the Buyer is notified of the hanging weight and prior to processing by the processor. Any unpaid balance after the due date may result in the loss of each deposit and forfeiture of the ability to purchase an animal.

With respect to Family Package, an Additional Deposit of one-third of the Purchase Price shall be paid to Farm not less than five (5) days from notice being provided to Buyer by the Farm as to the scheduled date of processing and prior to Transportation and Delivery of Cattle to Processor.

The final balance for the Purchase Price is due within five days after the Buyer is notified by the Farm that Processor has completed processing and beef is available for pickup by Farm. Any unpaid balance after the due date may result in the loss of each deposit and forfeiture of the ability to purchase.

Processing & Additional Fees.

With respect to one-half or whole cow purchases, processing fees ARE NOT included in selling price and Buyer will be solely responsible for payment of all associated fees to processor.

Animal Husbandry.

The animal parentage will be 100% Registered Black Angus and raised as follows:

- Fed Non-GMO feeds
- Raised without use of antibiotics
- Raised without the use of added hormones & steroids
- The animal is fed, raised and finished with corn, grain, hay and grass feed in an unconfined manner.

Emergency Care.

Prior to Purchase, in the event that the animal requires medical treatment, the Farm will notify the Buyer immediately. Either the Farm or the Buyer will have the option to continue or to cancel this contract. In such event as either the Farm or the Buyer may elect to cancel the contract, a full refund of the deposit will be issued to the Buyer.

Pick Up and Delivery of Product from Processor.

The Farm shall be responsible for delivery of the animal to a USDA approved facility for processing, whose address and contact information are as follows:

- The buyer shall be responsible for all arrangements to pick up the final product at the processor, or,
- The product will be picked up at the processor by the Farm and delivered to the Buyer, in which case a delivery fee of \$ 75.00 will be paid to the Farm for this service.

Risk of Loss.

Buyer assumes risk of loss for the animal once delivered to and accepted by Processor.

Buyer assumes all risks and liabilities upon purchase of the animal and shall forever indemnify, defend, and hold the Farm, its agents, representatives, employees and shareholders harmless from any liens, claims, losses, liabilities or expense including attorneys' fees, court costs and other expenses resulting from Buyer's purchase as outlined herein.
